## Activities

### TEACHING FOR IMPROVED GENDER EQUALITY AND RESPONSIVENESS

Ensure that primary and lower secondary school children are protected from school-related gender-based violence through the transformation of the Teacher Education College and 40 schools in Battambang Province into centres of excellence for gender-responsiveness.

#### ACTION GUIDE

A practical guide for teachers, school leaders and school support committees on how to make their school gender-responsive, safe and learning-friendly for all children.



#### TEACHER EDUCATION COLLEGES

Capacity development for 30 teacher trainers and management staff at the Battambang Teacher Education College.

#### PILOT SCHOOLS

Capacity development for 240 teachers, school leaders and school support committees of 20 primary and lower secondary schools.



#### CIVIL SOCIETY

Capacity development for 5 civil society organisations on establishing 20 additional gender-responsive primary and lower secondary schools.

#### OUTREACH CAMPAIGN

Outreach, advocacy and sensitisation campaign on the prevention and protection of girls from all forms of violence.

#### Why?

- Violence against girls and women in Cambodia remains an issue.
- Traditional gender norms remain a constraint for women and girls to participate in social development/education.
- School-related gender-based violence (SRGBV) is a serious obstacle to achieving gender equality.
- Education is critical in empowering and transforming the lives of young people, both girls and boys.
- School, home and the community play important roles to end all forms of violence against women and children.

#### Objective

All primary and lower secondary school children are protected from school-related gender-based violence, enabling their equitable participation in all spheres of life at school and at home by transforming one TEC and 40 schools in Battambang Province into **centres of excellence for gender-responsiveness**.
